BeyondHome assists working families in their quest to go from homelessness to self-sufficiency for life.

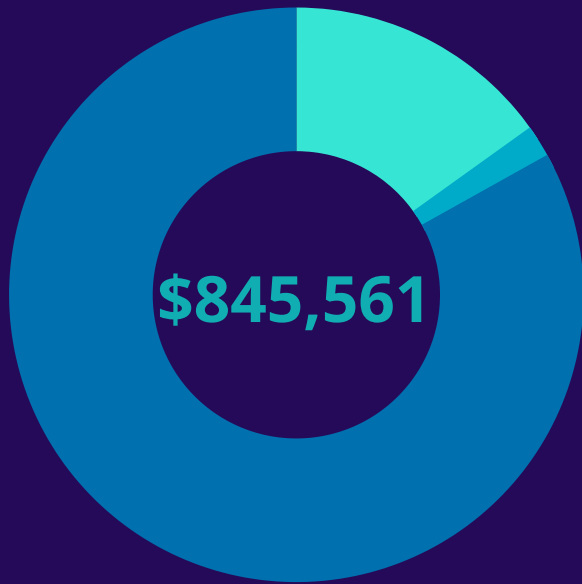
BeyondHome has had significant impact in the community for more than 30 years. Since housing the first family in December 1988, BeyondHome has housed 543 families with children. Of those families, 446 families have graduated from BeyondHome. 20 families have graduated since 2016. Everyone of those families is still self-sufficient today.

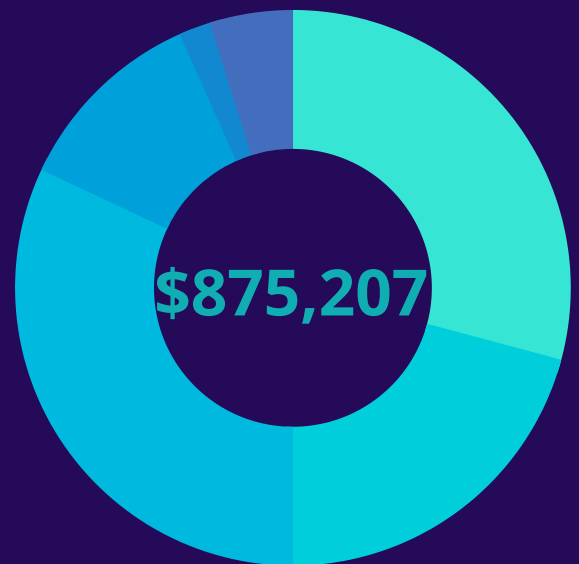

What we did



HOUSING

This is where the journey begins. BeyondHome has 40 housing units in Jefferson County that range from 2-3 bedrooms. Residents pay 30% of their income in rent.



CASE MANAGEMENT

The foundation of BeyondHome's services is individualized case management. Case managers see, love, and empower residents to become all they were created to be.



FINANCIAL LITERACY TRAINING

Participants take classes that include the emotional aspects of money with traditional financial literacy. Participants are also able to receive one-on-one coaching from *mpowered*.



LIFE SKILLS COACHING

Residents attend bi-monthly courses throughout the year that focus on job readiness, parenting, relationships, financial freedom, nutrition and cooking, and more. Childcare is provided.



PARENT COACHING

In addition to group courses offered, residents have the opportunity to receive one on one coaching to help them with their day to day parenting challenges.



CAREER MANAGEMENT

BeyondHome Case Managers work with community partners to do career assessments and to offer guidance in choosing, preparing for, and succeeding in a livable wage career.



COUNSELING

BeyondHome partners with eight counselors and covers the cost of trauma-informed therapy for families and individuals who need the care of private practice counselors.

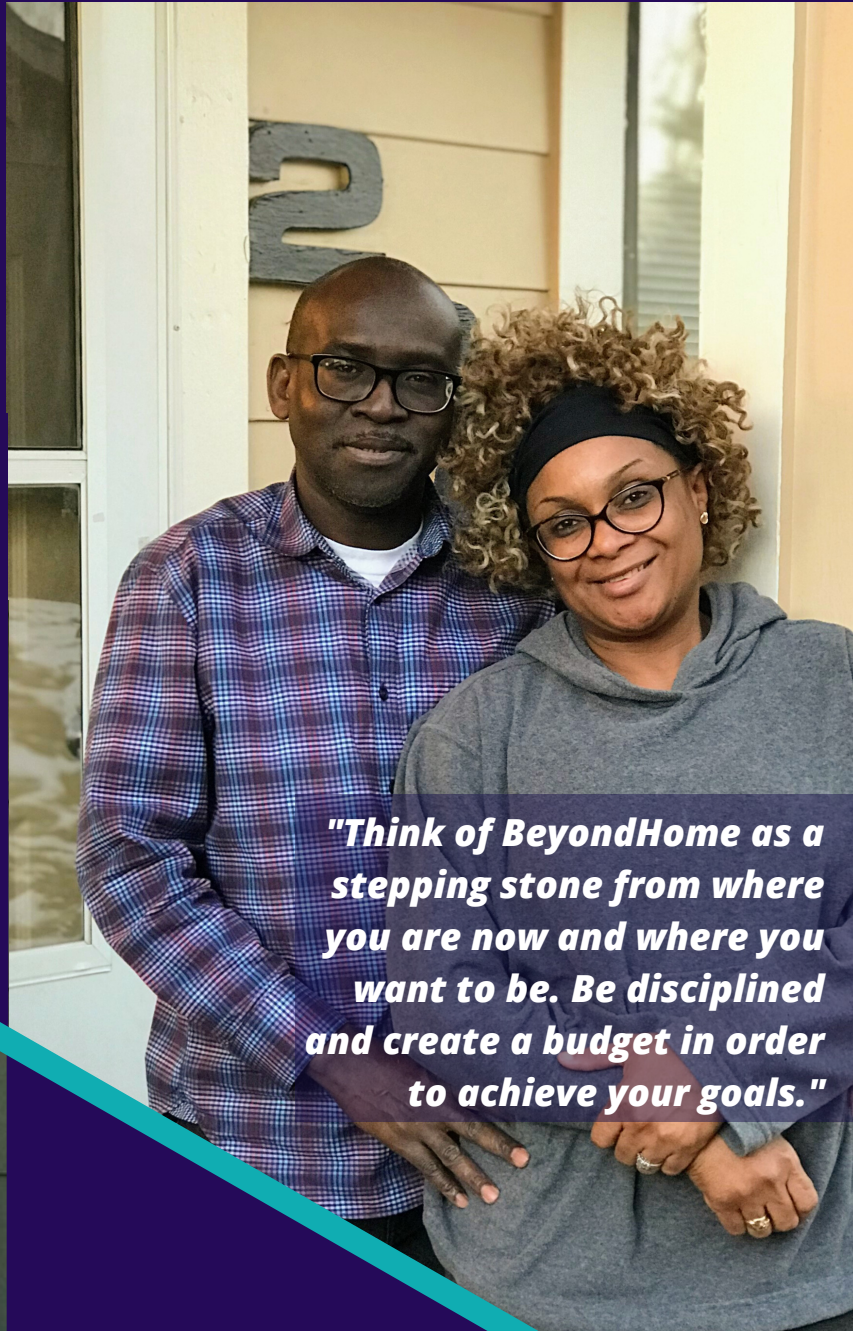


YOUTH PROGRAMMING

Children are encouraged to participate in our weekly Whiz Kids tutoring program offered onsite throughout the school year. BeyondHome also has a Summer Youth Program which combines enrichment activities with summer fun.

Nyunga and Kazadi came to BeyondHome in 2017 as refugees from the Democratic Republic of the Congo with their three kids after living in an apartment they could not afford. They needed a safe and affordable home to live and adjust to a new culture while they worked hard to save up and buy a home. Kazadi works at a medical supply store. Nyunga passed her C.N.A State Licensing Exam and began working in her new field soon after. They quickly learned English and began serving in their community. After 18 months, they were able to purchase their first home in Thornton, CO.

Irina was in an abusive relationship for 28 years when she worked up the courage to leave. She heard about BeyondHome from a friend that went through the program. She moved in with two of her kids in May 2016. Irina says the counseling that she received changed the direction of her life. Irina realized that she needed to find a better job. She started her own cleaning business and got her Real Estate License while also helping with Russian interpretation. Irina graduated from BeyondHome in August 2019 and is renting at market rate with plans to buy a home of her own.
